Scope: These rules shall apply to this contract.

Underlying: The Underlying for this Contract is bills that have become law after Issuance and before <date>. Revisions to the Underlying made after Expiration will not be accounted for in determining the Expiration Value.

Instructions: The Underlying can be found at: <https://www.congress.gov/>. These instructions on how to access the Underlying are provided for convenience only and are not part of the binding Terms and Conditions of the Contract. They may be clarified at any time.

Source Agency: The Source Agency is the Library of Congress and *The New York Times*.

Type: The type of Contract is an Event Contract.

Issuance: After the initial Contract, Contract iterations will be listed on an as-needed basis at the discretion of the Exchange and corresponding to the risk management needs of Members.

<date>: <date> refers to a calendar date specified by the Exchange. The Exchange may list iterations of the Contract corresponding to variations of <date>.

Payout Criterion: The Payout Criterion for the Contract encompasses the Expiration Values that a bill has become law which has abolished or dissolved the Federal Reserve Board of Governors and its constituent reserve banks before <date>. The bill need not take effect before <date> to be included in the Payout Criterion.

An example of a bill that would be encompassed within the Payout Criterion, were it to be passed after Issuance and before <date>, is H.R.8421, "[Federal Reserve Board Abolition Act](#)".

Minimum Tick: The Minimum Tick size for the referred Contract shall be \$0.01.

Position Accountability Level: The Position Limit for the \$1 referred Contract shall be 25,000 contracts per strike, per Member.

Last Trading Date: The Last Trading Date of the Contract will be the same as the Expiration Date. The Last Trading Time will be the same as the Expiration time.

Settlement Date: The Settlement Date of the Contract shall be no later than the day after the Expiration Date, unless the Market Outcome is under review pursuant to Rule 7.1.

Expiration Date: The latest Expiration Date of the Contract shall be <date>. If an event occurs that is encompassed by the Payout Criterion, then the Expiration Date will be moved up in accordance with Rule 7.2.

Expiration time: The Expiration time of the Contract shall be 10:00 AM ET.

Settlement Value: The Settlement Value for this Contract is \$1.00.

Expiration Value: The Expiration Value is the value of the Underlying as documented by the Source Agency on the Expiration Date at the Expiration time.

Contingencies: Before Settlement, Kalshi may, at its sole discretion, initiate the Market

Outcome Review Process pursuant to Rule 6.3(c) of the Rulebook.
